## Outlaw Event Information

The race will start and finish at  
**El Dorado's East Park  
Corner of Central and Locust**

### Run Course Description

Runners will get to view some of El Dorado's finest scenery as they run along this mostly flat course. Only a couple hills will slow you down as you turn right onto the bike path, run over a fishing bridge, and continue running along the river on River Road past an orchard and fields on this out and back course.

### Bike Course Description

The bike portion of the race will be a somewhat flat course with some rolling hills along the way. The scenic route will take you out towards the lake on highway 77. Riders will take a right on Myers road and continue on Boulder Bluff Road and Shady Creek Road. Riders will again take a right onto 177 for a stretch while enjoying the scenic landscape of central Kansas. You will then take a right on to highway 54, this last 5 mile stretch will be fast and mostly downhill.

### Bike Check In and Transition

Bikes may be checked in Saturday morning starting at 6am. The transition area will be located in the East Park parking lot and will be roped off. This is where all transitions including team transitions will take place.

### Runner Comforts

Aid stations with water and snacks will be located throughout the run and bike routes. Showers will be available at the El Dorado YMCA after the race.

## Registration Information

Participants can register in person at any Greater Wichita YMCA by using the printed form on the reverse side or mailing the form to the El Dorado Branch YMCA.

Race Day Registration will be at the start and finish line at East Park in El Dorado.

Registration must be received by August 2 to guarantee a shirt.

### Packet Pick up

Will be at the El Dorado YMCA on Aug. 20th between 9 am and 7 pm.

### Awards

Awards will be given for the top male, female, and team. Awards will also be given for the top Clydesdale and Athena racers.

Age group awards will be given out in the following categories: 0-13, 14-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60+.

### Outlaw Rules

1. **An entrant may not transfer his/her entry.**
2. **All bike participants are required to wear a helmet.**
3. **For two person team participants, one person is the designated runner, the other is the biker.**
4. **Participants are required to have their race number visible at all times.**
5. **Once the event has begun, only bikers are allowed in the bike staging area.**
